
STANDARD WORK is the documented record of the best known way to complete a task under normal condition. This information contains the instructions that are followed to ensure the accurate outcome.

work standards define the steps that must be done to deliver a product or service that meet customer's requirements.

STANDARDIZED WORK defines the known best way to perform the task and sets expectations on how to complete the work.

WHEN & WHY

The creation of Standard Work helps reduce variation and improvement in outcomes, ultimately benefiting the patient. Because it creates a baseline of performance, standard work is often considered a first step in the continuous improvement journey.
